



Welcome to the Land and Resource Use Survey!

Project Tuckamore (the Project) is a diversification initiative proposed by Corner Brook Pulp and Paper Limited (CBPPL) in western Newfoundland. The Project is intended to support the future of the Corner Brook mill, strengthen the forestry sector, and increase the use of renewable energy in mill operations. It includes four interconnected components: forestry modernization, upgrades at the Corner Brook mill, improvements to Deer Lake Power facilities, and development of a new wind farm.

The proposed wind farm is undergoing a provincial environmental assessment as part of the permitting and approval process. This survey will help CBPPL better understand communities and land and resource use activities in and around the proposed Wind Farm Site. The information collected will support the environmental assessment and Project planning.

The survey is intended for people who live in, visit, or use lands and resources in or near the proposed Wind Farm Site, including hunting, fishing, trapping, gathering, recreation, cabin use, or other activities.

Please note that no contact information will be requested, and responses will be reported in summary form and used to support the environmental assessment and Project planning. The survey should take 10 minutes or less to complete. It will be open to the public until October 9, 2026.
